



Professor Andy Evans has been Professor of breast imaging at Dundee University since 2009, Prior to this he was a consultant radiologist in Nottingham.

His main research interest is shear wave elastography (SWE) of the breast. Andy is also currently developing a pre-operative prognostic index for breast cancer based on imaging and core biopsy findings which should help patient selection for neo-adjuvant systemic therapy.

Other recent research projects have focused on the use of tomosynthesis in symptomatic women and percutaneous vacuum removal of the sentinel node in women with breast cancer. Past funder have included FP7 (EU) the EPSRC while current funders are the CSO and Breast Cancer Now.

Andy is also an accomplished musician, he plays the French Horn, is a published composer and is founder and conductor of the Dundee Chamber Orchestra.
