



**Prof. Eva Maria Fallenberg** completed her general radiology training from 1998-2004 & worked as the responsible consultant of breast imaging in the University of Münster, organizing the first courses for the German Breast Screening program held in the Reference Centre of Mammography Screening in Münster.

Since 2007 she has worked as a consultant and Team manager in Breast imaging at Charité Universityhospital Berlin. Her main research interests are contrast enhanced mammography and MRI in which she has performed several studies both in Berlin and also in collaboration with Clarisse Dromain and the Institute Gustave Roussy in Paris published in several peer review journals including *Radiology*, *Investigative Radiology*, *European Radiology*, *Breast cancer Research*, *Breast cancer Research and treatment*. In total she has published more than 70 peer-reviewed scientific manuscripts, review articles and book chapters. Prof. Fallenberg has also presented more than 100 scientific and educational lectures at the most prestigious radiology conferences worldwide. In addition, she is the subsection editor for Breast of *Acta Radiologica* since August 2015.

Since January 2019 she is the Section Chief of diagnostic and interventional Breast Imaging at Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich.

She is also very interested in teaching and training and in 2011 became a founder member, examiner and Chair person of the EUSOBI Board of the European Diploma in Breast imaging (EDBI) and is the head of clinical instruction of medical students for the radiology department at LMU.

She holds a doctorate degree in Medicine since 2001 and in February 2015 finalized her habilitation (tenured professorship) on “contrast enhanced imaging of the breast-challenges, limitations and technical innovations”

She was a member of the Breast Scientific Subcommittee for the European Congress of Radiology (ECR) 2016 and 2017 and is the Breast Subcommittee Chair for 2020.

Actual she is Chair Person of the board of German breast radiologists as well as Executive Board member of the EUSOBI.
